The figures are based on statistics reported by CoB member Bureaux in their capacity as Handling Bureau for Green Card accidents occurring in their territory. The CoB assumes no responsibility for the accuracy of the data provided. Rows represent Handling Bureaux, columns represent Guaranteeing Bureaux.

Accidents reported to / handled by Correspondents in the countries of the following Bureaux are omitted or not fully reported in the above table:

- A 14,510 additional accidents (breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)
B 27,000 additional accidents (estimated, breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)
CY 8 additional accidents (breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)
D 10-15% additional accidents (estimated, breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)
E 31,000 additional accidents (estimated, breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)
I 2,246 additional accidents (breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)
IRL 75 additional accidents (estimated, breakdown by country of registration of the involved vehicle unknown)

1,262 additional accidents were reported by Handling Bureaux, involving vehicles registered in countries outside the Green Card system or vehicles with unknown country of registration, of which:

- 927 accidents reported by the PL Bureau (country of registration outside the Green Card system)
129 accidents reported by the GB Bureau (country of registration unknown)
68 accidents reported by the TR Bureau (country of registration outside the Green Card system)
49 accidents reported by the MK Bureau (country of registration outside the Green Card system)
31 accidents reported by the SRB Bureau (country of registration outside the Green Card system)
29 accidents reported by the EST Bureau (country of registration unknown)
29 accidents reported by other Bureaux (country of registration outside the Green Card system)

As a result of these omissions, the numbers of accidents reported in the above table per Guaranteeing Bureau may also be understated.

The Bureau of Israel (IL), in their capacity as Handling Bureau, has not responded to the CoB enquiry.
